

The 12 days of Christmas 2025

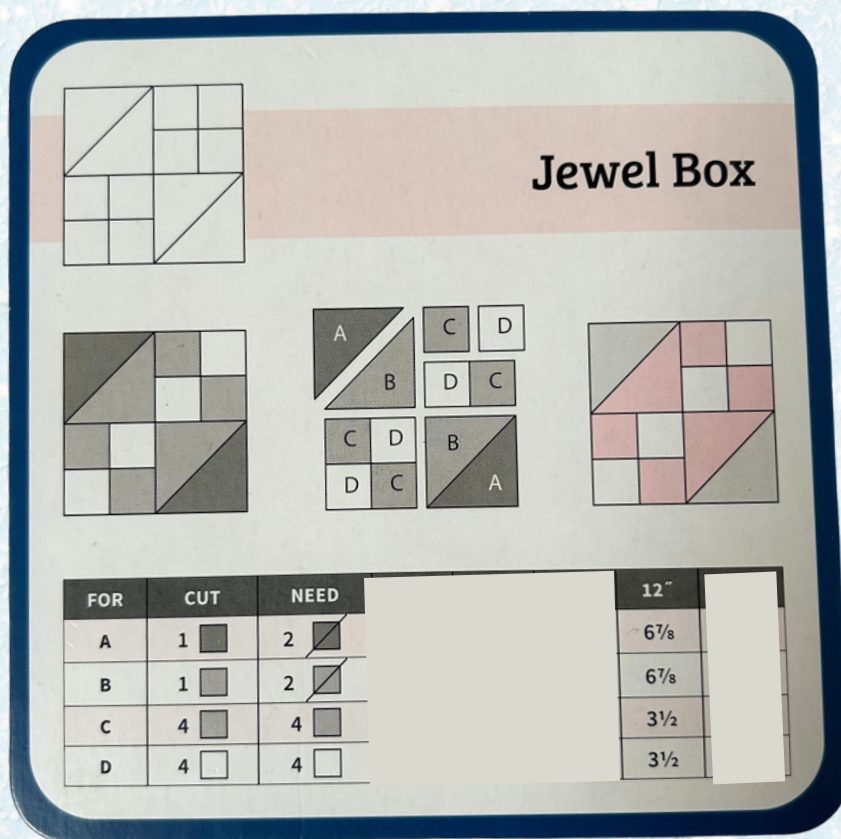
We are making a block keeper, and then 9 blocks to go inside, so a lovely keepsake, something a bit special plus you'll have enough blocks to make a small quilt if you wish! It's going to be a fun 12 days!

Day 6 - Jewel Box

This block is 3 of 9 to store in your block keeper. Don't worry if you cannot follow the cutting or piecing diagrams, that's what I am here for! We will cut and sew the pieces together, nice and slowly. The Facebook live videos will be uploaded to Youtube and added to the 12 Days of Christmas playlist on my channel.

All of our blocks are from the first set of the Quilt builder card deck.

Jewel Box
